Measure across back from joining of one arm to joining of other

Measure around neck

Trousers length




Measure from top of waist line to bottom of cuff

Trousers Inseam




Measure inseam from crotch to bottom of cuff

Trousers "U" Crutch



Measure from the top of the waistband in the front to the top of waistband in the back

Thighs




Measure around thigh at widest point
